

MEMBERSHIP

A membership for Bluffs Shooters is a family membership, including spouse and family members living at home up to the age of 19. The annual dues is \$120, renewing every January. In addition there's a \$60 work bond, for a total of \$180.

After working a total of only 8 hours on approved club projects throughout the year you will receive a full work bond credit applied to the following year. Each member will have a work bond card and it will be their responsibility to have the hours noted and signed for by the work coordinator at the time the work is performed. When the 8 hours are completed the card can be turned in for credit.

To become a member an applicant must be a current member of the National Rifle Association (NRA) and have a current Nebraska Firearm/Handgun Purchase Certificate or equivalent (current law enforcement, FFL, concealed carry permit or other approved background check). After the new membership is accepted the applicant will attend a range orientation after which they will receive their membership card and range key. A member has unlimited access to the range during daylight hours.
