600 Yard And 1000 Yard Range Rules

- 1. Close and lock the gate when you enter and leave.
- 2. Stay on the road.
- 3. Put the range hot flag up at the gate when entering and down when leaving.
- 4. The 600 yard and 1000 yard ranges CANNOT be used at the same time.
- 5. Put up the range in use flag at the 600 yard or 1000 yard firing lines when you arrive.
- 6. Put the range in use flag at the applicable firing line at half-mast whenever heading down range for any reason. This is for your safety if another shooter arrives at the range while setting up targets. Put the flag all the way up when shooting.
- 7. The match in progress flag is located just west of the 600 yard firing line. The range is closed unless competing when this flag is up.
- 8. Do not use the seven match target frames unless you are using a target designed for them.
- 9. Only shoot targets in designated target areas.
- 10. Only shoot intermediate targets at club installed target areas. Do not shoot cement blocks.
- 11. Only use the cement walkways to go on the firing line by foot and never drive up the firing line.
- 12. Pickup your trash, targets and report any safety concerns to the board members.
