

2024 Nebraska State Long Range F Class Championship

This is an NRA Registered Tournament

National Records can be set

Time and Date: This match will be held on August 23rd, 24th, and 25th of 2024. There will be open practice on August 23 starting at 1:00 pm and lasting until 5:00 pm. On the 24th and 25th the signup and squadding will begin at 8:00 am with first shots down range by 8:30 am.

Sponsor and Location: Sponsored by the Bluffs Shooters Inc. – Scottsbluff, Nebraska. The range is located 7.3 miles north of Scottsbluff on Hwy. 71, then 2 miles west on CR B, then 1 mile north on CR 19, then 6 tenths of a mile east to the 1000-yard line.

Eligibility: Open to anyone 16 years of age and older that can legally own and safely handle firearms. Anyone younger than 16 years of age must obtain permission from the Match Director prior to the match.

Entry Fees: \$60 per competitor - \$40 for shooters under 20 years of age.

Entries: Entries will be accepted after the first of June and close on the 20th of August. The entry form is on the bottom of this bulletin. Entries can be delivered in person or mailed to:

Rules: 2024 NRA F Class Rules will be followed. No armor piercing or incendiary ammunition is allowed. ***All attendees will be required to wear eye and hearing protection while on the firing line. ECI (empty chamber indicator) must be always in place except during the 3-minute prep period or live firing. The Match Director has final say in all situations.***

Targets: NRA approved LRFC targets will be used. Shotmarker electronic target systems will be keeping score for reference and displaying shots. Provide your own tablet or smartphone for scoring.

Classifications: Classification will be based on NRA Classifications. There must be at least 3 in a classification to be recognized. If less than 3 are in a classification, they will be advanced upward. Competitors that are not classified will compete in Master class.

Categories: There will be two categories for these matches:

F Class Open Rifle

F Class Target Rifle

Pair Fire Portion: Shooter #1 is always on the right and goes first. In matches 1-4 If you want to convert your first sighter, you MUST take your second sighter also. If you only want to convert your second sighter, you do not have to take your first sighter. The shots will alternate back and fourth. The score must be called out and acknowledged by the shooter before the next shooter fires. There is a 45 second time limit to get the shot off once it is acknowledged.

Match Course of Fire:

Saturday

August 24th – 1000 yards – 8:00 Check-in and squadding – 8:15 Safety Briefing – 8:30 First Shots Down Range

Match 1: Pair Fire – Blow off – 2 convertible sighters, 20 shots for record.

Match 2: Pair Fire – 2 convertible sighters, 20 shots for record.

Match 3: Pair Fire – 2 convertible sighters, 20 shots for record

Match 4: Pair Fire – 2 convertible sighters, 20 shots for record

Sunday

August 25th - 1000 yards – 8:00 Check-in and squadding – 8:15 Safety Briefing – 8:30 First Shots Down Range

Match 5: String Fire – Unlimited Sighters – 20 shots for record. 25 Minute time limit.

Match 6: String Fire – Unlimited Sighters – 20 shots for record. 25 Minute time limit.

Match 7 is the Grand Aggregate of Matches 1-6

General Information:

Even though Shotmarker targets are being deployed, your spotter will keep score during both Pair Fire and String Fire. After firing, the scores will be verified and turned into the Range Officer. If you desire to challenge a shot, you must notify the Range Officer immediately. If you continue to fire without notifying the RO you will not be able to challenge. Each challenge will cost you \$10.

Awards: Will be given for High Overall Tournament winner, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for each category (Open and Target Rifle) and 1st, 2nd, 3rd of each match. High Overall, 1st Open, and 1st Target Rifle are not eligible for Special awards.

Special awards may be awarded also such as High Senior, Senior, Lady, and Junior depending on attendance.

Water will be provided – no meals available so bring lunch and snacks.

No coaching is allowed after the first round is fired.

Squadding will be random. Partners and firing points will change after the first day.

The Match Director has final say in all matters.
