SUMMARY OF RULES

1 The event will be run as a COLD RANGE, meaning that all firearms will be unloaded, chambers clear and have no magazine inserted at any time except at a firing point and when the competitor is under the direction of a Range Officer. 2 NO alcohol on premises. 3 Guns must be fired in full auto only (except in semi-auto class). 4 Guns may be altered, providing such alterations in no way interfere with the safety of the firearm. 5 Only pistol calibers are allowed. 6 All NFA rules and firearms laws apply to all firearms on premises. 7 No armor piercing, incendiary, exploding, multiple projectile, steel core, steel jacketed, or hollow point ammunition is allowed. 8 No competitor will wear, carry or use two or more firearms simultaneously in any competition. 9 Only the first run in each class will be counted for score. 10 All competitors and spectators are required to wear hearing and eye protection. 11 No competitor will be allowed to hold ammunition or magazines in his/her hand during competition except during the process of loading, unloading, or reloading. 12 If a malfunction cannot be cleared and firing continued within a reasonable time, the competitor will be obligated to accept the "did not finish" (DNF) time. 13 The Executive Range Officer or Range Officer may, at their discretion, disqualify any competitor for a violation of rule(s). 14 All firearms must be rendered safe and slung (or carried) muzzle down or cased when moving on or off the range or between areas on the range. 15 A competitor shall present his/her dispute to the Range Officer within 30 minutes of the occurrence in dispute. The Match Director is the final authority in the resolution of disputes.
